#### **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

#### Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

# Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
  - in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
  - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
    - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
    - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
  - (a) "security activity" means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
  - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

#### Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

#### PROMOTION OF LICENSING OBJECTIVES

#### A) GENERAL – ALL FOUR LICENSING OBJECTIVES

All staff will receive in house training on licensing act 2003 and our particular operating schedule

All staff will be asked to sign to confirm that they are aware of their responsibilities

#### B) THE PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

Anyone acting in a quarrelsome or drunken manner will be asked to leave and if necessary the police informed.

Alcohol will not be sold to any person who is drunk or who appears to be drunk

Alcohol will not be served to the companion of a person who is drunk for the drunken person's consumption

#### C) PUBLIC SAFETY

External lighting will be installed.

Health and safety risk assessment will be carried out

No pets will be allowed onto the premises.

Fire alarm system will be installed and fire exits clearly visible.

Disabled friendly facilities.

Comprehensive first aid kit located on premises.

Public liability insurance in force – our insurers will be advised regarding our operating schedule

#### D) THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC INSURANCE

Toilets will be cleaned regularly.

Bins will be lidded at all times.

Restaurant is located at least 100 meters from the nearest property. Windows and doors are double glazed and will be closed after 2300 when live entertainment takes place, except in very warm weather. Noise levels will be regularly monitored by staff and adjustments made if necessary.

The main purpose of the business is a restaurant – music will not be played on a regular basis.

#### E) THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM

Persons under the age of 18 will be refused alcohol at all times, however a 16 or 17 year old is allowed to drink beer, wine or cider with a table meal provided that an adult purchases the drink. Any person who looks under 21 will be asked for I.D. Only photographic I.D will be regarded as proof of age, E.g. passport, driving license. If in doubt staff will be advised not to serve. Children under 15 will be accompanied by an adult
