## Item 3 – A schedule describing the route

Land at Penrodyn, Teifi Terrace, St.Dogmaels Road, Cardigan.

Footpath - from Teifi Terrace to Castle Street, Cardigan...

Leaving St. Dogmaels Road (B4546) opposite no. 4 Teifi Terrace, footpath measures 3metres' width at entrance, but approx. 2metres for remainder of length. Tarmac surface reasonable for initial distance approx. 27metres. Remaining 21metres, at North-Easterly end of footpath, in very poor condition and surface in need of repair.

Footpath measures 48metres in total. Gentle slope at entry off Teifi Terrace, getting steeper at North-Easterly end, where surface is poor.

Long-established route between St. Dogmaels Road/St.Dogmaels village and the centre of Cardigan town, avoiding lower part of St. Dogmaels Road, leading to junction with Castle Street (where pavement is poor and incomplete). Used as route to school, work, shops, entertainment.
