Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
 - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
 - (b) in respect of premises in relation to-
 - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
 - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
 - (a) "security activity" means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
 - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

PROMOTION of LICENSING OBJECTIVES.

- a. General All four licensing objectives: We will ensure that staff are instructed regarding the provisions of Licensing Act 2003 and this operating schedule.
- b. Prevention of Crime and Disorder: We will comply with the requirements of the Licensing Act and ensure that customers comply with the law. Our premises are fitted with burglar alarms and good quality locks. We have a policy on underage sales (see box e below).
- c. Public Safety: Fire extinguishers- please see plan, they will be regularly serviced. First Aid Kit- Staff are aware of location. Public liability insurance in force and we will advise our insurers of this application.
- d. Prevention of Public Nuisance: We are situated in a small village location however we will advise our customers to leave quietly and signs will be erected. Although we will be able to open to 24.00hrs our general hours will be considerably earlier.
- e. Protection of Children from Harm: Staff will be instructed not to sell alcohol to anyone who appears to be under 18. They will challenge anyone who appears to be under 21 years and demand photographic ID i.e. driving licence, passport or Pass/Valid logoed cards. If in doubt they will not serve.
