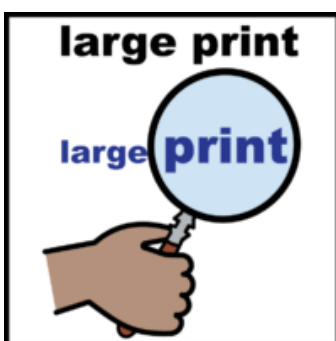

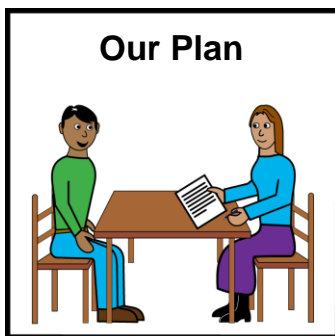

Our employees and money will be directed into these areas.

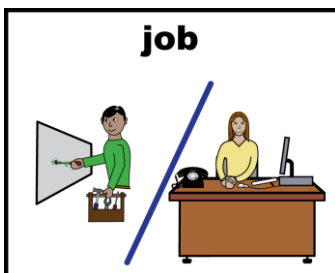
