

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## Schedule describing the route: Land at Penrodyn, Teifi Terrace to Bridge End, Cardigan SA43 3AA

FOOTPATH known locally as PENRODYN, from Teifi Terrace to Bridge End, Castle Street, Cardigan.

LEAVING St. Dogmaels Road B4546 opposite no.4 Teifi Terrace, footpath measures:

4,5m width at road edge

3,3m width at inside edge of pavement

For remainder of route, measures approx 2m width until disabled ramp linking route with Castle Street – here narrowing to 1,1m, with handrail on right-hand side.

Tarmac surface reasonable for initial distance, approx. 27 metres. Remaining 21 metres down to 32 Castle Street in worse repair, although some re-surfacing work carried out in recent years. Route then continues across the Public Right of Way (parallel to the old trunk road, Castle Street, Route Code 78/23, Coastal Path) and towards a ramp leading to Castle Street B4546. On crossing Castle Street, access is afforded along the Teifi Walkway to the Teifi Marshes Nature Reserve.

LENGTH of route = 63 metres from road edges A & B.

This is a long-established route between St Dogmaels village, via St Dogmaels Road (B4546) into the centre of Cardigan town, thereby avoiding the lower part of St Dogmaels Road (lower Teifi Terrace/ Castle Street) where the pavement is poor and incomplete.

It is used widely as a route to school, work, shops, entertainment.

There is reference locally to a bench that was erected on the lane (now long since disintegrated and removed) and there are street-lights in operation as follows:
