## **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

### **Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol**

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence—
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

### **Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:**

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
  - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
  - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
    - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
    - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
  - (a) “security activity” means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
  - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

## Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

### **a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)**

We are a volunteer committee, that runs and maintains the hall as a facility for the local community. Our income is largely derived from hirings of the hall. We have a long-term objective to keep the hall in good condition, encourage its use by the community and to form a useful and important part of the community. Our approach to the four licensing objectives reflects our own objectives as a community facility.

### **b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

We insist that all events are adequately supervised by hirers, and that hirers have rules and a plan to deal with disturbances  
No events are allowed that involve music and dancing that are organised from outside the village  
We try and notify the police of any events where alcohol is on sale.

### **c) Public safety**

We maintain the hall to all known safety standards  
Last electrical safety check in 2005 led to upgrading of the fire safety lights  
Fire extinguishers are checked annually  
Fire safety lights are checked monthly  
All curtains are made of material that is fire-retardant

### **d) The prevention of public nuisance**

The majority of public nuisance is likely to be from unsupervised young people. We insist on hirers having adequate supervision and door persons to control access.

### **e) The protection of children from harm**

Alcohol only allowed at events by specific approval of the hall committee, and not at any events involving young people.  
Smoking is not allowed in the hall.
