Supplementary Planning Guidance to the Ceredigion Local Development Plan Adopted June 2015

The above draft Supplementary Planning Guidance was approved for public consultation by Ceredigion County Council on the 28th January 2015.

The consultation began on the 19th February 2015 and ended at noon on the 8 April 2015. About 288 letters and emails (depending on their contact preference) were sent to consultees on the Local Development Plan database. The consultees were informed that the consultation documents were available free of charge on the Authority's web site and that paper copies were available to view free of charge in the libraries (including mobile libraries) within Ceredigion.

The documents were provided free of charge to the Town and Community Councils within the Ceredigion. The consultation was advertised via the Authority's web site and via a public notice within the Cambrian News which appeared in the 19th February 2015 edition.

All responses were acknowledged, and are publically available. A total of 7 individuals and organisations made 12 individual comments. The officer responses to the consultation on the Supplementary Planning Guidance for Community and the Welsh Language were reported to the Ceredigion County Council at its meeting on the 23rd June 2015 (available at http://www.ceredigion.gov.uk/cpdl/Democratic_Services_Meetings_Public/I%202015_0623.pdf Minutes were confirmed in the Council meeting on 24/09/2015 (Minutes 23/06/15, Minute Number 12) http://www.ceredigion.gov.uk/cpdl/Democratic_Services_Meetings_Public/A%2024.9.pdf .

The Council following discussion resolved to:

- i) agree that Policy DM01 should continue to be applied in full as set out in the adopted LDP (which includes the requirement for a Community and Linguistic Impact Assessment);
- ii) that delegation be provided to Officers to respond to the comments received and make minor amendments to the Community and the Welsh Language SPG and to subsequently adopt the Supplementary Planning Guidance on the Welsh Language.
