Aberystwyth

CCC-ABER13-CP Parc yr Onnen to Rheidol Trail	Useful connection from the Llanbadarn area to the Rheidol Trail and wider Aberystwyth network. The route is let down by the unsuitable surface and lack of maintenance to surrounding environment. Upgrade is proposed to widen path where possible, provide suitable surface and connect the route through Parc yr Onnen, subject to funding. Improved cycle route signage required at junction on A44 Trunk Road which will require WG involvement.
CCC-ABER30-CP Promenade - Harbour to Terrace Road	This is a useful route connecting the Ystwyth & Rheidol Trails to the Promenade and town centre. The route lacks suitable signing throughout and is narrow on the southern section which includes two way traffic adjacent to parked vehicles (approx. 3.5m wide over 170m length of carriageway), though traffic speeds are low.
CCC-ABER15-FW Heol y Bont link to Rheidol Trail	A useful connection that is generally well maintained and was well used at the time of audit. The path is only just under the pass threshold due to the very steep gradient which might cause problems for those with mobility issues and the adjacent busy road.
CCC-ABER19-FW (Penglais Road from junction with A44 to junction with Waunfawr Road)	A well-used route from town centre to the University. The route lost marks due to the steep gradient and high traffic volume about which little could be done.
CCC-ABER21-FW Mill St and Alexandra Road (A487)	This is a useful route connecting the town centre & rail/bus station area to Penparcau Road. There is a high volume of traffic on the A487 trunk road and narrow footways on Mill Street (1.2m pinch point, mostly over 1.5m wide over a 100m section) but the route has low pedestrian flows.

CCC-CAR02-SUP Cardi Bach Trail to Cilgerran Wildlife Park	This popular route is part of National Cycle Route 82 and provides access to the Station Road Industrial area. There are several pinch points near the Castle Street end requiring some 'give and take' during peak levels of activity, but for most of the time flows are low.
CCC-CAR12-SUP A487 (from junction with Aberystwyth Road B4548 to Pont y Cleifion roundabout)	A new cycle route connecting communities to facilities from North to South and vice versa. The lack of directional and destination signs, along with the presence dismount signs positioned to the south leave cyclist abandoned to find their way onto the busy carriageway. Route signage linking route to Cardi Bach Trail would also be beneficial.
CCC-CAR05B-FW Maes y Haf	This relatively quiet but short route is an important link to school and leisure facilities located along Napier Street. Resurfacing and increasing footway width would greatly improve access to Napier Gardens.
