Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed
 - in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
 - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
 - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
 - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
 - (a) "security activity" means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
 - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

The following conditions are attached to the Premises Licence detailed above:

1. The Licence is limited to the sale of alcohol for consumption on or off the premises during the hours:

Monday to Saturday 11.00 to 23.00 Sunday 12.00 to 22.30

12.00 to 22.00 12.00 to 15.00 and 19.00 to 22.30 Christmas Day

Good Friday 12.00 to 22.30

New Year's Eve: Between the end of the permitted hours in the premises on New Year's Eve and the beginning of the permitted hours in the premises on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours in the premises on that day, midnight on New Year's Eve).

A period of 20 minutes is allowed at the end of each period for the consumption of intoxicating liquor on the premises.

2. The Premises Licence will be subject to the imposition of all embedded conditions converted from the Licensing Act 1964.
