Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
 - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
 - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
 - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
 - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
 - (a) “security activity” means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
 - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

General- all four licensing objectives

The following conditions are attached to the Premises Licence detailed above:

- The Premises Licence will be subject to the imposition of all embedded conditions converted from the Licensing Act 1964.
- For persons who have consumed a meal at the premises, 30 minutes drinking up time is allowed
- For those persons who are resident in this premises alcohol can be consumed and sold to those persons and their bone fide guests at their expense 24 hours a day
- 1 SIA Doorperson will be present when Live and Recorded music take place, after 8pm
- Doors and windows to be closed during regulated entertainment
- No Entry / Re Entry after 0000 hrs
- No under 18yr olds to sell / serve alcohol

There will be a sign showing licensed in pursuance of act of parliament for public dancing and music. No disorderly conduct shall be permitted on the premises of any exhibition, film, recitation, acting, singing or dancing which is of an obscene character or offensive. The licensee shall retain control over all parts of the premises. No alterations or additions to premises shall be made except with the prior approval of the licensing authority. All parts of the premises, and all fixtures and fittings therein including seating, door fastenings and notices, floors, carpets and furniture shall be kept clean and maintained in good order to the satisfaction of the licensing authority. The public part of the premises shall be kept properly and sufficiently ventilated and heated. Adequate and apart sanitary conveniences suitably marked, shall be provided and maintained for persons of each sex. No unlawful lottery or game shall be permitted on the premises.
There will only be one drink per customer served at last orders.

The prevention of crime and disorder

Lighting exterior areas-vicinity of club and major routes to and from club around site are all lit. Violence-Door Supervision-the venue is primarily a family entertainment venue, never promoting cheap alcohol as a sole attraction, with strict codes of conduct. There is a selective, but non discriminative policy on door control. Guests are provided with membership cards at the campsite owners' discretion. Exclusion of troublemakers-Anyone who looks at all doubtful, through dress or behaviour is refused entry. Drug dealing and Abuse-The presence of owners who constantly survey and are vigilant. Staff are trained in what to look for. No open bottles or glasses taken outside of the beer garden or club premises

Public safety

Capacity Limit 195 inc staff. Fire Risks-Weekly test emergency lights, every two months minimum test fire evacuation procedure and assess fire risks, recorded in fire safety book and actioned within one week Fire warning code for staff to use in evacuation procedure. All exits and emergency routes highlighted. Appropriate fire fighting equipment is available and staff will be trained to use it. No one to smoke, drink or eat on dancefloor while in use for dancing. No smoking in the vicinity of all the bar areas. Smoke filters in bar area. Electrical installations are approved annually by certificate. Immediately prior to the admission of the public the nominated supervisor on duty will check all exits and passageways are unobstructed and functional. All standard conditions requested by the fire safety officer in the interests of health and safety will be adhered to. The licensee will maintain suitable and sufficient insurance in respect of risk of fire and third party claims arising from the use or the condition of the premises

The prevention of public nuisance

Prevention of mass exodus at closing times-One hour drinking up time to stagger volume. People leaving in a noisy or boisterous manner are marshalled from the premises and if persistent are banned. People congregating outside premises are moved on. Last entry time 11pm. Bins located at tradesman entrance to club, outside club and around park, emptied daily. People are not encouraged to drink outside after dark. Residents of the park are reminded in the club rules of the behaviour standards required in the clubhouse.

The protection of children from harm

All children under 16 are accompanied in any bar area by an adult. Staff fully trained on under 18, only photo ID is accepted. No children under 16 will be admitted to the club on occasions when we have blue comedians

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

Determination

The application for a New Premises Licence was granted subject to the following amendments and conditions:-

1. All terms and conditions as set out in Mediation Schedule 01/09/05 i.e.
Ix SIA Doorperson will be present when Live and Recorded Music takes place after 8pm; Doors and windows closed during regulated entertainment; no entry/re-entry after 2400 hrs; no under 18's to sell/serve alcohol.
2. That noise limiting devices be installed at the premises
3. Daily monitoring of the noise levels at the camp. A log to be kept detailing dates and times of monitoring the level of noise heard, the source, and noting the action taken when required
4. No placing of glass bottles in receptacles outside the premises after 10pm.
5. No consumption of alcohol in open air after 11pm
