#### **Out of Hours Emergency Team**

### What if you need to contact Ceredigion Social Care during the evening, at night or the weekend?

We know that not all unexpected major problems happen during normal office hours or can wait until the next day. Ceredigion Social Care provides an Out of Hours Emergency Team that is there to help with these emergencies.

To contact the Out of Hours Emergency Team phone:

#### Who will answer the phone?

Calls are answered by an operator from Delta Wellbeing in Carmarthenshire who will take your contact details. They will then pass this information over to the duty Social Worker who will telephone you.

When the Social Worker telephones you, it is important that you give them as much information as you can about the person needing help including:

- The person's full name
- Date of birth
- Address
- Telephone number
- Where the person is and the nature of the crisis
- Services and help the person may be getting at the moment

 If they have not had previous contact with Social Care or you are unsure please provide details of their ethnic origin and first / preferred language

#### What happens next?

The duty Social Worker will explore your concerns with you. They may give you advice and guidance over the telephone on how to deal with the problem, or:

- Recommend that you contact another more appropriate agency. They will give you the contact details
- Refer the matter on to another Social Care team for the next working day
- In some circumstances they may visit you or the person in need / whose welfare you have concerns about

### When does the Out of Hours Emergency Team operate?

**Weekdays -** 5.00 p.m. to 8.45 a.m.

**Weekends -** Friday 4.30 p.m. to Monday 8.45 a.m.

Bank Holidays - 24 Hours

#### What sort of problems can the Out of Hours Emergency Team deal with?

Here are a few examples of the sort of problems we can help with:

Child Safeguarding matters

- Adult Safeguarding matters
- Older people who are at risk or who need immediate help
- Concerns relating to someone with a physical or a sensory impairment
- Support for carers and people with severe learning difficulties or mental health problems
- Mental Health Act assessments
- Parenting difficulties with children and young people
- Appropriate adult for juveniles and vulnerable adults in police custody
- Provision of emergency accommodation for people who are vulnerable
- Emergency Support and Advice for Foster Carers

Ceredigion County Council wholeheartedly supports the principle of equality and recognises the importance of fair access and actively promotes equality of opportunity for all service users and carers.

#### **Advocacy Service**

There is an Advocacy service available and where possible we will arrange for someone to help you put your point across in your dealings with us if you are not able to do this yourself and don't have family or friends to help you.

Ceredigion Independent Professional Advocacy (CIPA) can assist if you (or your carer) are over 18 years of age, live in Ceredigion and are currently having an assessment or review of their care and support needs or have a safeguarding concern.

#### **Representations/Complaints/Comments**
