Crynodeb o'r Materion / Summary of Issues

As agreed at the last meeting volunteers were sought to take part in a Task & Finish group to consider options for a formal launch of the 2023-2028 Wellbeing Plan.

The group met on 22 April 2024 and included support from members of the Co-Production Network. There was wide discussion regarding a launch event and how best to promote the WB plan.

The majority of opinion was that given the time that had elapsed since the WB Plan had been published the PSB would be better served by engaging in a series of events throughout the summer to share the contents of the plan and increase public awareness of the activities of the PSB.

The approach suggested was to participate in a number of appropriate community events and provide an information stand to inform the public of the intentions and achievements of the PSB and what we are looking to deliver. Hopefully then to raise awareness in the community of the PSB's work and that of its sub-groups.

With this strategy in mind Chairs of our delivery groups undertook to encourage further discussion in the sub-group meetings regarding opportunities for attendance at suitable local events. They would also ask for people prepared to volunteer to assist and take part.

Since the last PSB meeting was postponed, there has been a further round of sub-group meetings where such discussions have taken place.
