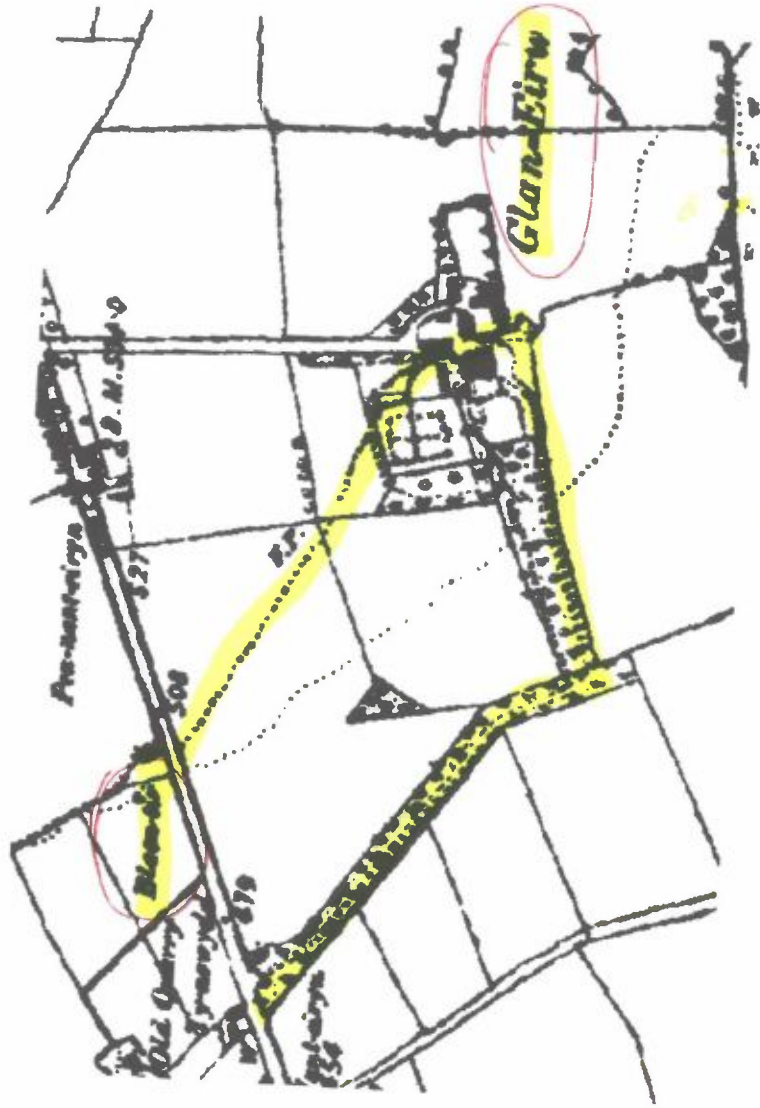

If the footpath was open I could then have access to the pavement in Blaenporth, which would allow me to walk to Church, view Blaenporth Castle and have access to other footpaths leading to the coast in Aberporth and various other destinations.

Walking is a great way to improve my health and well being and will also allow me to interact with the local community.

### Item 3 – describing the route

The five bar gate opposite Blaen Tir (Wheelgate Cottage) SA43 2AX leads onto land belonging to Glaneirw House.

The footpath leads onto the lower track, which exits to the pavement in Blaenporth.

The five bar gate opposite Blaen Tir is approx. 10 feet wide (3.048 m)

The gates on the lower track, which adjoin the pavement in Blaenporth, are also 10 feet wide (3.048 m) and the path visible beyond is also the same width as the gates.

I am unable to walk or measure the distance of the footpath as the gate opposite Blaen Tir has been locked since the end of December 2013.
