Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence—
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
 - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
 - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
 - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
 - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
 - (a) “security activity” means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
 - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

a) General – all four licensing objectives

We have public liability insurance in force. There are no steps in public areas. We have a fire extinguisher and a first aid kit.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises is in an isolated location. The hours of operation suggests that we will never create a nuisance to neighbouring properties.

c) Public safety

Staff will be instructed to challenge anyone attempting to purchase alcohol who appears to be under 21. They will ask for ID and proof of age. If in any doubt staff will be instructed not to serve them.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The premises is in an isolated location. The hours of operation suggests that we will never create a nuisance to neighbouring properties.

e) The protection of children from harm

The premises is in an isolated location. The hours of operation suggests that we will never create a nuisance to neighbouring properties.
